Supplementary Regulations

**CAMS PERMIT No.
318/1205/01**

1. The “Gymkhana at The Racecourse” shall consist of a **Multi – Club Gymkhana**, herein called the event. The Event will be held under FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules (NCR) (CAMS), the National Motorkhana Code and these Supplementary Regulations issued by the Organisers or any Further Regulations that are issued.
2. The event is to be Organised and Promoted by the Vintage Sports Car Club of Vic.Inc.(VSCC) P.O. Box 401 Mulgrave North 3170
3. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au
4. The Event will be held at the Newstead Racecourse and Recreation Reserve, Guildford Rd. Newstead and run on a dirt surface.
5. The Organising Committee is - Robert Sales, Ashley Tracey, Roger Rayson, Stephen Hands.
6. Clerk of the Course- Robert Sales *CAMS ID 9909590 (Judge of Fact)*
7. Entries close on 12th May 2018. The entry fee is \$30.

Cheques to be made out to the VSCC
Entry forms must be completed in full and accompanied by the entry fee.
The Event will be limited to 60 starters, accepted in the order of receipt.
One entry per driver, maximum of two drivers per car.
The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without assigning any reason therefore in accordance with the provisions of NCR 83 of the CAMS manual of motor sport.
8. The Event is scheduled to start at 2.00pm and Drivers Briefing will commence at 1.45pm.

9. Scrutineering will commence at 1.00pm and finish at 1.45at the venue. Vehicles shall comply with General Requirements for vehicles & Drivers Schedule A of the current CAMS Manual, Log Books (if issued) must be presented at Scrutiny. All Competitors must present the following documents at book-in, CAMS Licence, Club Membership & CTP Extension as applicable.

10. Classes
 - A: up to 100in. wheel base
 - B: over 100in. wheel base
 - C: Junior

11. General Requirements
 - Drivers of open vehicles must wear goggles/visors as per current CAMS Manual of Motorsport -schedule D.
 - All vehicles with front opening bonnets, must have two bonnet catch mechanisms, each to hold the bonnet firmly in place should the other fail as per the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport
 - A fire extinguisher, to a standard listed in Schedule H of the current CAMS Manual of Motorsport, must be securely fitted to the vehicle.
 - Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual of Motorsport.

12. All competitors are required to wear clothing, of a fire resistant material, that covers the body from neck to wrist to ankles and suitable footwear.

13. All Drivers must hold a current CAMS level 2NS or higher Licence.

14. Trophies will be awarded to 1st in each class.

15. Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the Event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual of Motorsport.

16. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.

17. Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti Doping Policy will apply.

18. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

19. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual of Motorsport.

20. Vehicles must comply with Schedule A and Group H of the current CAMS Manual

21. DIRECTIONS TO VENUE

From Castlemaine drive through Newstead turn left, after crossing the bridge, onto the road to Guildford, continue for approx. 1/2 mile, then follow the prompts. If staying for dinner and films BYO drinks and chair.
